

# Notice of Construction: Rough Acres Main Construction Yard Sunrise Powerlink® Transmission Line

On December 18, 2008, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) approved San Diego Gas and Electric (SDG&E) Company's Sunrise Powerlink Transmission Project. Preparation of some construction yards for the project are scheduled to begin in late July or mid August 2010, with the majority of construction expected to start in late-2010 once the CPUC issues Notices to Proceed for each segment. Issuance of Notices to Proceed will be contingent upon SDG&E compliance with pre-construction requirements as specified by the approved mitigation measures.

As part of the project, temporary construction support sites will be required along the route with main construction yards located in the Alpine and McCain Valley areas. The proposed Rough Acres site will serve as a temporary storage yard for construction materials and equipment. Parking of vehicles and equipment during working hours for limited off-site staff will be required. Construction materials and equipment will be delivered to the site, unloaded, temporarily staged and ultimately transported to designated construction areas along the approved route. SDG&E has arranged and secured a lease term of 3 years for this site. This portion of the project does not include transmission construction activities. Construction of the transmission line is scheduled to begin later this year following issuance of Notices to Proceed by the CPUC.
